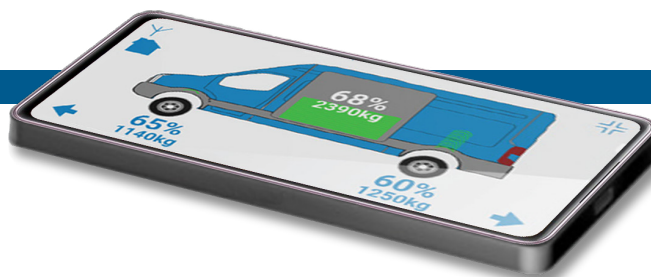


VanWeigh Lite[®] Driver Guide



Overview

The VanWeigh Lite system uses WI-FI technology to communicate with a WI-FI enabled mobile device. Ensure the device is connected to the VanWeigh Lite WI-FI address and open the mobile device web browser to operate the system

Starting the system

- Turn on the vehicle ignition.
- Ensure the mobile device WI-FI is turned on and connect to the VanWeigh Lite system SSID.
- It is recommended that the web browser page is saved as a favourite and WI-FI auto connect is enabled on the mobile device for the VanWeigh Lite system SSID.

Home page views

Touch and swipe left or right to view the weighing information in an alternative view.

Weighing information

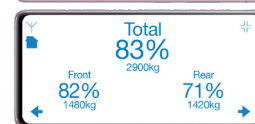
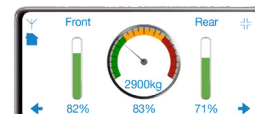
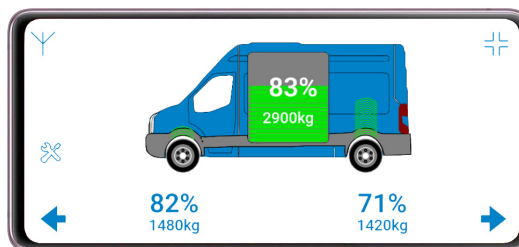
The weighing information is displayed in three values:

Total. This is the total weight of the vehicle and its percentage of the maximum weight that can be applied.

Front. This is the weight of the vehicle that is currently over the front axle and its percentage of the maximum weight that can be applied to that axle.

Rear. This is the weight of the vehicle that is currently over the rear axle and its percentage of the maximum weight that can be applied to that axle.

Note: The weighing unit is set when the system is configured and calibrated for use.



Overload alarms

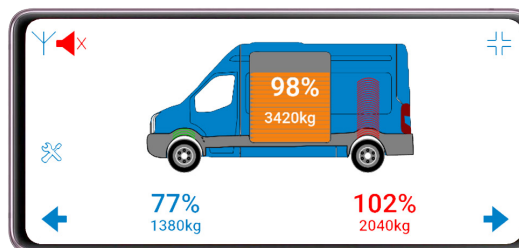
Weight indicators are displayed with each type of weight value. The indicators are colour coded:

Green indicates that the current weight is below 90% of the maximum vehicle gross weight, or the maximum axle weights.

Amber indicates that the current weight is between 90% and 100% of the maximum vehicle gross weight, or the maximum axle weight.

Red indicates that the current weight is over 100% of the maximum vehicle gross weight, or the maximum axle weight.

100%. This triggers an audible alarm. Tap the mute icon to mute the alarm.

How to navigate the web app

Use the mobile device to navigate the web app to access the menus and edit the settings.



Connection icon. This indicates that the device is connected to the ECU.



Connection lost icon. This indicates that the connection to the ECU has been lost.



Sound on icon. Tap to mute the app audio.



Muted icon. Tap to unmute the app audio.



Expand icon. Tap to expand the view to full screen.



Collapse icon. Tap to shrink the view to fit the browser window.



Home Icon. Tap to return to the home page.



Settings icon. Only available in the home screen. Tap to open the set up menu.



Back icon. Tap to go back to the previous page.



Forward icon. Tap to go to the next page.

How to adjust the display settings

1. Tap the settings icon on the home page to open the set up menu.
2. Tap the User Options tab to enter the user options menu
3. The Power off time sets the duration of time the system will remain on after ignition power is removed. Tap the digit to open the numeral pad to edit the power off timer.
4. Tap the drop down box to change the language. English, French, German and Spanish are available.

5. Tap the drop down box to edit the home page. This dictates the home page graphics when the system powers on.
6. SW Version displays the system version. This is for information only
7. After changing settings a "Save changes?" prompt will appear. Tap "Yes" to save new settings, tap "No" to discard the changes.
